BABY MOSES CRISPY CAKES



You will need:

- 85g Shredded Wheat
- 200g Milk Chocolate
- 1 big bag of Jelly Babies
- Cupcake cases

Instructions:

1. Break your chocolate into small pieces and place in a microwave safe bowl.
2. Ask a grown up to help you melt the chocolate by microwaving for intervals of 30 second, then stir and return to the microwave for another 30 seconds. Keep doing this until your chocolate is melted, making sure to mix it every time otherwise your chocolate will burn.
3. Next break up your shredded wheat and add to the chocolate mixture.
4. Spoon the chocolate into 12 cupcake cases and as they begin to dry squash a spoon into the middle of them to create a basket shape.
5. Place one jelly baby in each basket and leave to finish drying.

Paper plate Basket weaving

YOU WILL NEED:

- Paper plate
- Wool
- Scissors



Instructions:

1. Begin by cutting out small v cuts all the way around edge of your plate, make sure you have an odd number of tabs left behind.
2. Bend each of the lips up towards the middle.
3. Tie your first wool colour to one of the lips and begin to weave in and out, swapping colours whenever you wish.
4. Tie the last colour off with the first and bend the tops of your lips over to stop your weaving from coming loose.
