MOSES AND THE BURNING BUSH

UNPACKED

In our story this week we hear how Moses was called by God to free the Israelites from Egypt. By now Moses is no longer living in Egypt himself. Moses grew up in Egypt but could not bear to see his people being hurt, he got angry and killed an Egyptian soldier and so he had to run away from his home in order to stay alive.

When God calls Moses in our story today Moses has been living in Midian for 40 years. This didn't matter to God, He still called Moses to go to Egypt to free God's people. Moses was terrified, he didn't think God had called the right person, but God never makes mistakes. Despite Moses insisting that he is not the right person for the job, God tells him that he is and gives him all the tools he will need to be successful.

The same is true for us. God sometimes calls us to do things that we don't think we can handle, and maybe sometimes like Moses we try to insist that we are not the right person for the job. God is always right and he will always make sure that we have everything we need to succeed.

We may be called to do something small like talk to our friends about our faith or it may be something much bigger. Whatever it turns out to be it's important that we remember God wants us to succeed and he will give us everything we need to make sure that we can.

When we live our lives in a way that pleases God, when we follow his commands and include him in our life, then we are walking God's way.





CREATE YOUR OWN IMAGE OF A BURNING BUSH

You will need:

- Card
- Pencil
- Paint - brown, green, red, yellow and orange
- Paint Brush
- Straw
- Water
- Cup



Instructions:

1. Start by drawing around your hand and arm to create a tree.
2. Paint inside your handprint with brown paint and let dry.
3. Take a clean paint brush and create leaves by dabbing the bristles of your paint brush down lightly and let it dry.
4. Once your tree is dry, Take some yellow paint and a small amount of water and mix together - you need your paint to be runny enough to drip off the paint brush.
5. Place some drips around your tree and blow the paint with the straw, this will give you "flames"
6. Repeat the process with orange and red paint until you are happy with the result and then allow to dry.

THE TOOLS TO DO GOD'S WORK


DIFFERENT PEOPLE USE DIFFERENT TOOLS DEPENDING ON THEIR JOB
