

STORY EXPLAINED

We have chosen the story of Peter and Cornelius this week because this is the first time in the Bible that the story of Jesus is shared with people other than the Jewish. In the story Peter has a vision which helps him to understand that the good news of Jesus dying for our sins is for everyone not just the Jewish.

God is telling the apostles to go out and tell EVERYONE and that is exactly what they do. This message hasn't changed God still wants us to go out and tell EVERYONE. It can sometimes be hard to share the love of Jesus with others - but because God is always with us we have nothing to fear. So next time someone asks you why you go to church remember God is by your side helping you to answer the question so you don't need to feel afraid or embarrassed because you have something that everyone needs. 
NOW EMPTY THE CAN AND TRY AGAIN

God's eye cross



Gods eye crosses are really pretty and super easy to make.

Why not have a go and then give as a gift through someone's post box who may be feeling a little bit lonely to remind them that God loves them and is always with them.

You will need.

2x sticks. These can be any sticks that you can find on your walk or even lollipop sticks.
some wool in different colours.

Begin by tying the sticks together in the shape of a cross using the first colour of wool you wish to use.



Then wrap the wool over and around each stick always going in the same direction.

When you are ready to swap colours simply tie the new and old colours together at the back of the stick so that the knot cannot be seen and then carry on wrapping.



Once you have finished tie your wool off.
