

STORY EXPLAINED

The next part of the Armour that we are given to put on are the shoes of readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.

In the reading from Acts we hear that God sends Barnabas and Paul and gives them the strength and power they need to share the Gospel of Peace.

They share the story of Jesus life with those they meet in Cyprus and God gives Paul the power to deal with the sorcerer Bar-Jesus.

In the same way God gives us the power to deal with people in our lives, if we have those who question the faith that we hold God will give us the words we need to tell them about Jesus and the Bible.

Make your own shoes

You will need:

Coloured Card

Pencil

Pen

Scissors

Tape

Ribbon



- First draw around a pair of your shoes and cut out the shapes.
- Then cut two strips of card to create the tops of your flip flops
- Place the strips over your feet and tape them to the bottom of the shoes shapes to create sandals.
- Cut the ribbon long enough to tie around foot and tape to the back end of the flip flop
- Lastly decorate your shoes in anyway you want to - I wrote G.

Scissors


Glue



- First you will need to draw the shape of a shield on the card.
- Cut out the shield shape and another strip of card long enough to go around your arm.
- Decorate your shield whichever way you want
- Then attach the strip of card to the back of your shield using the glue
- You now have a shield of faith

Prayer Bracelet

You will need:

Shrinking Plastic
Coloured Pencils
Hole Punch
Scissors
Ribbon



This week we are only going to be making the shoes and the shield.

- Draw pictures of your shoes and shield on the plastic and colour.
- Once you have coloured them, cut them out and bake them in the oven according to the instruction.
- If you don't have access to shrink plastic you can use number six plastic. This can be identified by this symbol  this plastic can be used in the same way as the shrink plastic.
- If using number six plastic then (with the help of an adult) heat in the oven at 165oC for 1-2 mins. Once you have followed the above steps.
- String your shoes and shield onto your the ribbon which already has your belt and breastplate and use the following prayer whenever you wear your bracelet.

Dear God,
Thank you that you have given us your Armour to protect us from Evil. Help us to put on the shoes of readiness, help us to be ready to spread the love of Jesus with everyone around us. The shield of faith gives us what we need to stand against anyone who tries to take us away from you so help us to wear these items of you armour with the belt and breastplate to keep us safe each day. Amen
